SEOUL

- **Gyeongbok Palace -** built in 1395, Gyeongbokgung Palace is also commonly referred to as the "Northern Palace" because it is the furthest north when compared to the neighbouring palaces, Gyeongbokgung Palace is arguably the most beautiful and remains the grandest of all five palaces.
- National Folk Museum a National Museum uses replicas of historical objects to illustrate the history of traditional life of the Korean people.
- Lotte World is a mojor recreation complex in Seoul, South Korea. It consists of the world's largest indoor theme park (a Guinness World Record). An outdoor amusement park called "Magic Island", an artificial island inside a loke linked by monarail, shopping mails, a luxury hotel, a Korean folk museum, sports facilities, and movie theaters.
- Love of Locks thousands of padlocks attached to the fence by romantic Seoulites symbolizing their undying affection.
- The Painters HERO Show HERO is an art performance that subverts everyone's imagination. The entire process of painting on stages combined with incredible visual effects and a witty blend of mime, dance and comedy. Audiences enjoy a play, an art show, and a musical performance through an 80-minute, excitement-filled show.

GYEONGGI-DO

- The Garden of Morning Calm the Lighting Festival is the biggest festival of lights in Korea, covering 100 thousand pyeong illuminated by 30,000 lights. The gleaming lights add a festive glow to the garden during the winter season.
- **Gwangmyeong Cave -** the cave re-opened in 2011 as a living museum and a historical site. Cave Aqua World, the music and art hall, and golden waterfall, golden paths and golden palaces adds extra mysterious elemets to its exisiting exotic atmosphere.
