## • 霞城公园

### • 藏王树冰

只要到了冬季,这片白雪皑皑的土地才变得特别生机勃勃,其因巨大的雪怪们尽情展示。这些雪怪其实是普普通通的大树,在其他季节本来不会有什么大事,但由于藏王山的严冬,这些紧紧挤在一起的树会变成了高大奇形的"怪物"。

### • 藏王狐狸村

这个著名的"村庄"饲养着 100 只种类的动物和 6 种不同类型的狐狸。如果想和狐狸们一起自由漫步,游客们必须进入藏王狐狸村内的保护区来执行。

# 第四天

会津若松市 - 宇都宫(包车)(酒店早餐)

### • 猪苗代湖

这个湖位于万代朝日国家公园内,是日本第四大湖,宽达 104 平方公里。猪苗代湖被誉为"天镜湖",一年四季都充满乐趣,不同季节有不同的活动和不同的背景。 冬季,您可以期待新鲜的粉雪以及滑雪和单板滑雪带来的冬季刺激。此外,此季时的海岸上还可能会看到迁徙的天鹅。

### • 大内宿

大内宿是位于日本福岛县南会津郡下乡町大字大内,修建于江户时代的会津西街道的"半农半宿"宿场。明治之后由于开通铁路,这一地区失去了宿场地位,转型为观光景区。1981年,该地被选入重要传统的建造物群保存地区。

### Tokyo - Ginzan Onsen - Yamagata (Day Tour) (B)

#### Ginzan Onsen

Located in the mountains of Yamagata Prefecture lies the secluded hot spring town Ginzan Onsen. Originally developed on the site of a silver mine, the quaint place is known as one of the best looking and atmospheric onsen towns Japan has to offer today. Fans of Hayao Miyazaki's work will instantly be able to tell this very location is the setting of his critically acclaimed work, the 2001 film, *Spirited Away*. Furthermore, visitors with an old-fashioned taste will be delighted to find the wooden inns of Japan, better known as Ryokan, many of which lined up along the town river ready to tuck you in!

### Yamagata - Mt.Zao - Aizuwakamatsu (Day Tour) (B)

### Kajo Park

The ruins of Yamagata Castle and its grounds are an expansive public park and a lasting reminder of the powerful Momogami feudal lords that once ruled the region.

### Zao Snow Monsters

Visiting Mount Zao in Miyagi during the winter means the snow monsters will be on full show as hundreds of trees on the mountains are glazed with snow and ice, rendering them into bizarre looking 'monsters'.

### Zao Fox Village

This famous 'village' is home to 100 animals and 6 different types of foxes, of which the latter are free to roam among the visitors should they wish to enter a preserve area inside Zao Fox Village.

# Aizuwakamatsu - Utsunomiya (Day Tour) (B)

## Lake Inawashiro

Located in Bandai Asahi National Park, this is the fourth largest lake in Japan as it spans across 104 square kilometres wide. Nicknamed the "Heavenly Mirror Lake", Lake Inawashiro offers great fun all year round with different seasons with different things to do with varying backdrops. For winter, expect fresh powder snow and winter thrills with skiing and snowboarding. There might also be the sight of migrating swans on the shores.

## Ouchijuku

Nestled in the southwestern mountains of Fukushima, Ouchi-juku is a great spot to visit thanks to its unique charm and history. This village was established under the post station system of the Edo period, and played a vital role as a rest stop for travelers.

The strikingly neon-lit Shinjuku districts are particularly popular with tourists for its buildings and its nightlife districts, consisting primarily of restaurants and bars.
