The South Shetland Islands, located between 61°S and 63°S, feature stunning glaciers, volcanic landscapes, and rich marine life. This region is an important habitat for penguins, seals, seabirds, and a variety of marine species, with nearby visible whale and dolphin populations.

We will visit one of China's key scientific research stations — Great Wall Station. Established in 1985, it is China's first international Antarctic research station, symbolizing China's growing strength in polar research and its commitment to international scientific collaboration.
